This policy addresses the personal and financial information that you have provided Hill Financial Group for the purpose of completing your financial plan, opening new accounts and/or processing transactions on your accounts. Under federal law, you have the right to know what information is being collected about you and how that information will be used.

Hill Financial Group collects and uses your non-public, personal information as needed to complete the agreed-upon scope of the engagement between you and our firm. This information will include, but is not limited to, your personal finances, your health, transactions between you and third parties, and information obtained from personal meetings between you and employees of our firm. **We will not disclose any non-public, personal information about you to anyone, except as required by law.** Under the law, the information we collect is provided to third-parties that perform support services on our behalf, as necessary, to effect, to administer, or to process a transaction, or for maintaining and servicing your account. **We do not give or sell information about you or your accounts to any other company, individual, or group.** We restrict access to non-public, personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information in order to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with and in most instances exceed federal standards to protect your non-public, personal information.

Every employee of Hill Financial Group has signed and is bound by a firm-wide, employment Non-Compete and Confidentiality Agreement which holds them to the strictest level of responsibility in keeping your personal and financial information private and secure from anyone outside of the firm. Employees are required to use all systems, processes, and software specifically designed or purchased by the firm in a manner that will always safeguard this information whether it is saved as a hard copy file or as an electronic data file.
